Who we are...

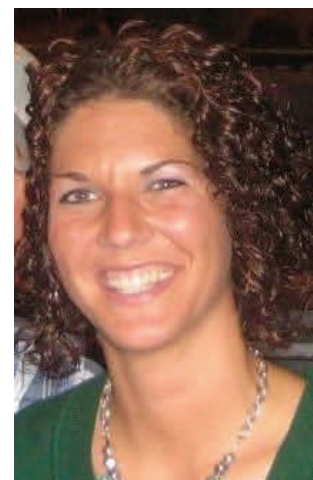
Melissa Baade:
